for us, amazon reviews are as important to our success as a good night's sleep is to a new parent, because they help spread good hiccavibes across America. so if you could please take a minute to review your wipe warmer, we'd sure appreciate it. and to make it really easy (which is important when kissing up like this), all you have to do is go to amazon.com/ryp to leave your review.

#hiccahint 1: don't expect "hot" wipes like you get from virgin air first class. that wouldn't make sense, because it would turn your wipes into tortilla chips. instead, our warmer gets juuust warm enough to take the "jolt" out of a cold baby wipe.



instructions (even ours) are generally boring, but please read them and just maybe you will find something useful. here it goes...

- 1. we suggest using "continuous feed" wipes because they pull the next wipe to the top. otherwise you'll constantly be fishing for wipes with your fingers.
- 2. load up 50-80 wipes and gently push the top wipe through the rubber opening in the main lid and lock the two slide locks.
- 3. after plugging in the adapter. let the wipes warm for a few hours, and then you are good to go. but just don't be surprised when your baby looks up the first time and says: "wow... thanks!"
- 4. don't forget that your wipe warmer works with both 120 & 240 voltages. this means you can take your wipe warmer anywhere in the world and it will work.
- 5. to use the nighttime changing light, press the red button. the light automatically shuts off within 10 minutes.

#hiccahint 2: when filling your warmer, pour a half cup of water over the wipes to prevent them from drying out too quickly. also, try adding some drops of lavender essential oil to the water. it smells great and calms babies. and did we mention "smells great"?
